Discussion and Decisions

The convenor of the CWDC proposed for a self defense workshop for the girl students. She expresses her concern for the girl students and also suggested a week long self defence workshop by inviting expert trainer. Members agreed on the workshop and suggested to make it free for the girl students and college will bear total expense of the workshop.

Looking to the increasing number of suicides by the youth and the psychological problems among youth in the country, it was suggest by Dr. Parag Shah to conduct a week long program under Care and Share. He suggested to invite different experts including psychiatrist to address the students. All members not only agreed upon but also suggested names of few expert which they will invite for the program.

Prof. Hiren Doshi has proposed for an inter-collegiate Art Carnival in which various competitions can be organized. Committee decided to go ahead with the proposal with partial funding from the college and the Rainbow Palett club will raise the remaining funds. Prof. Hiren Doshi was given the responsibility as Prof. incharge of the program.

It was decided in the previous meeting to conduct S V Desai Memorial lecture every year in association with AES and Alumni association. Alumni Association was given the responsibility to take the lead and invite personality of national repute. Names of few distinguished personalities were short listed in the meeting.

College had received a proposal from an NGO – Blue Ribbon for conducitng a three days Leadership training program for the students of various colleges at HL. It was decided to go ahead with the proposal but restrict it to students of H L College only. It was also decided to charge a nominal amount for the workshop.

Principal- Dr. Mona Kelshikar expressed a need to invite experts from industry to share their knowledge and expertise with the H L students on regular basis. She also felt that such lectures will expose students to the current developments in the industry and also will make them aware of industry expectations. Committee agreed to go ahead with the proposal and it was decided to arrange atleast 2 lectures every year.

Student General Secreatary had conveyed their desire to organize an awareness program and a competition on stock market for the students. It was decided to oraganize an inter collegiate competition in association with some private organization like BSE, NSE, broking firms etc. Sponsorship should be raised to cover the expenses of the event. Dr. Parag Shah was given the responsibility of being the Prof in-charge of the event.

H L Alumni Association expressed their desire to upgrade existing cricket ground a create a mini pavilion at the college. They also took up the responsibility of raising the funds for the same. College management showed their willingness to add the same amount that Alumni Association will raise. Alumni association was given the responsibility to lead the project and complete it in one year.
