Good afternoon everybody. He is an HL Alumnus from 2005-2008 batch and cleared his UPSC Civil Examination in 2014. Since 2015 he has been working in the Indian Revenue Service having been posted in Customs & Indirect Tax Department. During his youthful career he has trained at the National Academy Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics with extensive field attachments where he was awarded the Most Spirited Officer Trainee Award. Initially he was posted an Assistant Commissioner of GST till 2020. Thereafter he has worked as Deputy Commissioner, Customs and he is currently the Deputy Director in the Directorate General of GST Intelligence. He has led many investigations resulting in huge revenue augmentation with due diligence. In December 2021 under his leadership the DGGI team planned and executed a historical search operation in Kanpur which resulted in an unaccounted cash seizure of more than Rs.200 crores. It is a highest cash seizure by any investigation agency in the history of India.






#### "STEM Professional Certificate Program"


#### **Covid-19 Vaccine Drive**
