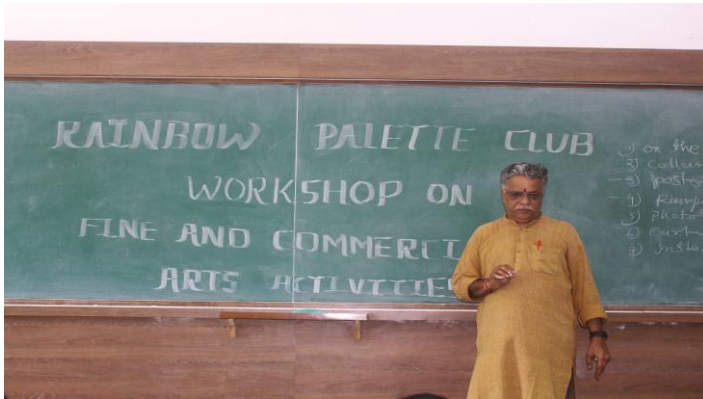

THEATRE CLUB

The Theatre Club organized a five-day theatre workshop which was conducted in the college to promote the importance of theatre and drama among the students. Objectives:

The primary objective of the workshop was to promote theatre and drama as a form of art among the students. The workshop aimed to:



Provide an understanding of the basics of theatre and drama to the students. Enhance the communication and interpersonal skills of the students. Develop acting skills and techniques in the students. Encourage students to participate in theatre and drama activities. Provide a platform for the students to showcase their talent in front of an audience.

Activities:

The five-day workshop was conducted by a team of professional theatre artists who provided training to the students. The activities included in the workshop were as follows:

Day 1: Introduction to theatre and drama

The first day of the workshop began with an introduction to theatre and drama.



The students were given an overview of the history of theatre and the importance of theatre in society. They were also introduced to the basics of acting, including voice modulation, body language, and facial expressions.

Day 2: Acting techniques

JOY OF GIVING WEEK

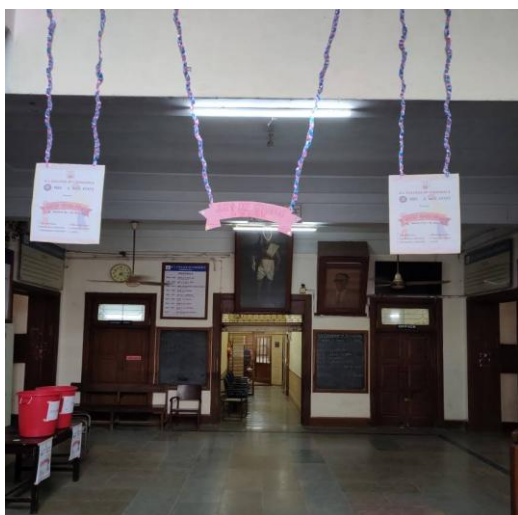
Joy of Giving week was organised by NSS group and Statistics department & of **H L College of commerce** from 22nd August, 2022 to 27th August, 2022.

The main motto behind celebrating this week was to bring a smile on needy students and orphan children.

During this week we have collected Stationary items for needy & poor students and Toys for orphan children, took a visit of cancer hospital (Vasna) and met the patients who are suffering from different types of cancer, and also organized a Blood donation camp with the help of RED CROSS BLOOD BANK at the college in which many faculty members and students donated a blood for children who are suffering thalassemia.



We hung a poster and hording of JOY OF GIVING WEEK at the entrance of the college so that everyone can see that and got information about the week. We kept 2 difference baskets in the porch of our college to collect the items. One of them was for collecting Toys and another one was for collecting Stationary items. 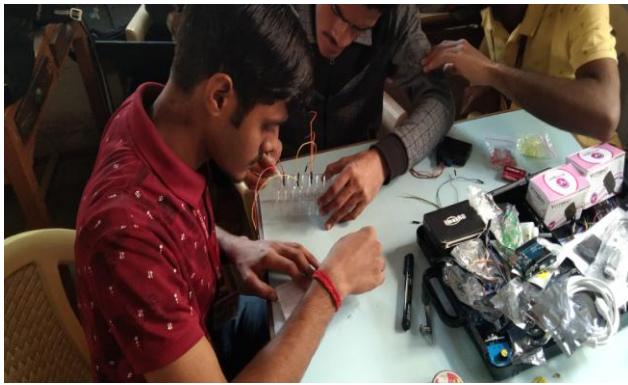
The Innovation Club organized a 4-day 20-hour Prabodh level training program at the

Innovation” on Amrut Navsarjan platform. Participants learnt the Basics of Block Coding, and used them to prepare animations and develop games. (17-1-2023 to 7-2-2023)
