Discussion and Decisions

Dr Shriram Nerlekar shared the format of a Teaching Plan based on Outcome Based Education (OBE). All faculty members agreed to the same.

Dr Mona Kelshikar suggested to use continuous and comprehensive internal evaluation of students at the college level. The IQAC members suggested online MCQ based test, assignments and written term-end exam. After discussion of weightage for each component, all IQAC members agreed.

In order to bridge the gap between education and industry requirement, Dr Shriram Nerlekar suggested that the college should offer self-financed market-driven short-term courses to the students. Practical skills acquired in these courses would make the graduating students industry-ready. Dr Nerlekar suggested courses such as Technical Analysis in Stock Market, Retail management, etc.

Dr Mona Kelshikar initiated the discussion on colaborations for student/faculty exchange with other institutions. Members pointed out difficulties. It was decided to explore possibility of collaborations.

Dr Parag Shah suggested that the college should sign MoU with organisations like GIFT City and NISM. Mr Shapath Shah agreed to help arrange a meeting between the college and officials at GIFT City soon.
