Discussion and Decisions

Dr Mona Kelshikar informed that the AU had shifted its B Com classes to another new building. The entire HLCC building was now available for the whole day. The IQAC suggested to change the college timings to morning time in order to address the long-standing demand of students and the society at large. Members discussed pros and cons of morning timings of the college. After this, it was agreed to request the AES management to allow HLCC to function in the morning timings now. It was also decided to apply to the Gujarat University to allow this change at the earliest before new admissions begin.

In anticipation of permission for morning timings from Gujarat University, IQAC members discussed about the options for the current students. It was decided to conduct an online poll to know how many students of SY and TY BCom would prefer to have classes in the morning timings. It was also decided to take the next course of action after student data is collected. Members also discussed the possibility of both morning and noon classes in the transitional year for the convenience of the students.

Expecting a change in the class timings for MCom as well, it was decided to conduct all MCom classes at the same time, mornings or evenings, and not to give choice to the students.
