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Discussion and Decisions

- Chairman of BOS, Dr. Nisha Bhavsar welcomed all the members of the BOS and had given introduction of Dr. S S Sodha, CA Amish Khandar, CA, Amal Dhru, Dr. Paliwal and Dr. Sagar Dave.
- Dr. NSB asked other board members (College Faculties) to introduce themselves.
- Dr. NSB presented the proposed syllabus of B.Com. prepared at the primary level:
 - 1. B.Com (GIA) (Autonomous)**
 - First Year (Sem – I)
Courses:
 - (1) Business Accounting
 - (2) Financial Accounting – I
 - First Year (Sem – II)
 - (1) Corporate Accounting – I
 - (2) Financial Accounting – II
- Dr. NSB asked the experts to give their inputs/suggestions/changes/inclusion/addition/removal to/from the syllabus prepared and presented to them.
- All experts had given their inputs/ suggestions as follows:
 - CA. Amal Dhru suggested to give more weightage to basics of accounting and to include Indian accounting standards, international accounting standards (IFRS) gradually in the syllabus.
 - Dr. Amish Khandhar suggested to keep case studies. He also informed that there will be lot of disruption in education in future. He suggested to have a full fledged course on GST.
 - Dr. S. S. Sodha suggested to include corporate restructuring in the syllabus. He also contributed valuable insights into the accounting and auditing standards to be included in the syllabus..
 - Dr. Sagar Dave suggested accounting concepts and conventions with accounting standards. He also complemented the syllabus as perfectly fine, only time limit is to be considered by the concerned faculty. He advised to give more weightage for creative and critical thinking on the part of students and more practical exposures rather than theory.
 - Dr. Udai Paliwal emphasized the need to align course learning outcomes with Bloom's taxonomy to enhance the quality of education and ensure compliance with outcome-based education standards. He recommended the use of measurable action verbs and structured assessment methods to facilitate effective student evaluation and skill development. The committee acknowledged his suggestions and agreed to incorporate these principles into curriculum design.
 - Dr. NSB had give vote of thanks to all external experts on the BOS for their valuable suggestions, inputs and recommendation and assured them to include in the syllabus. She also informed about second BOS meeting in online mode within short span of time with an agenda of acceptance of the revised syllabus considering the inputs and suggestions of the experts.
